About the Program

The Revvity Access CEM scholarship enables full-time graduate students from emerging markets to advance their studies and further their leadership development through a unique shadowing program with senior executives at Revvity.

Selected students receive a \$2,000 scholarship through the Revvity Foundation and are paired with a C-Suite leader at the company for a two-day shadowing program.

For the inaugural shadowing program, participating leaders include Revvity's Chief Strategy and Digital Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief People & Culture Officer, Life Sciences Business Unit Leader, and two General Counsel Vice Presidents.

MBAs and their senior leaders are also paired with an undergraduate student affiliated with CEM to create a collaborative learning experience that bridges academic insight at the graduate and undergraduate level with executive practice.

This scholarship program underlines Revvity's dedication to equipping the next generation of leaders and innovators with the skills necessary to address global challenges.

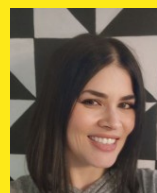
