International students may study on the Boston campus over the course of eight months or take an accelerated curriculum and study here for four months.

Our 4-month accelerated curriculum allows you to build your business expertise in just one semester. Many of our students pursuing this option return to their home country after completing one semester of study in the U.S. and transfer the credits they earned through these courses back to their graduate program. courses or 12 credits from a long list of eligible graduate business courses. From strategy to finance, you'll find courses that are most relevant to professionals working in any market.
