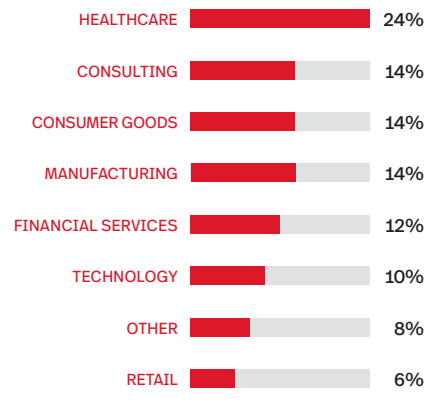
Employment Statistics

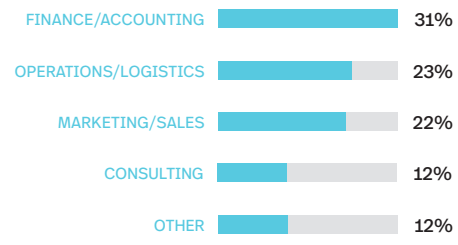

AVERAGE SALARY BY FUNCTION

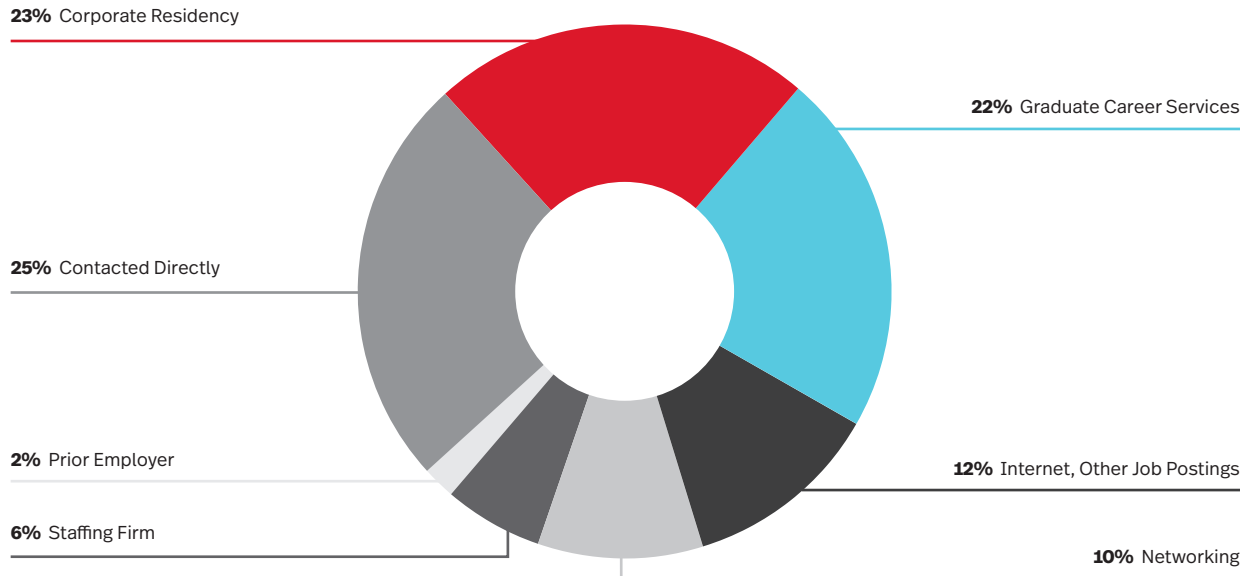
