PART-TIME CURRICULUM

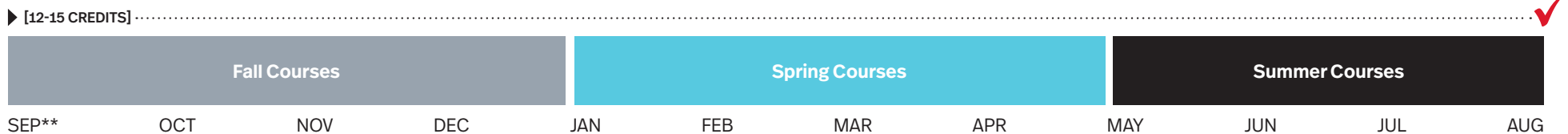
Develop your essential finance knowledge and accelerate your path to an MBA.

With a Graduate Certificate in Accounting and Financial Decision Making, you will gain the fundamental business skills to help them succeed when faced with real-world financial challenges. The minimum number of required courses to earn your certificate is four; however, many students select to take an additional elective to broaden their expertise. Students who complete the certificate with a cumulative GPA of 3.3 and a B or better in each of their classes may apply these credits toward the Part-Time MBA and get a head start on their degree.

FULL-TIME CURRICULUM (FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

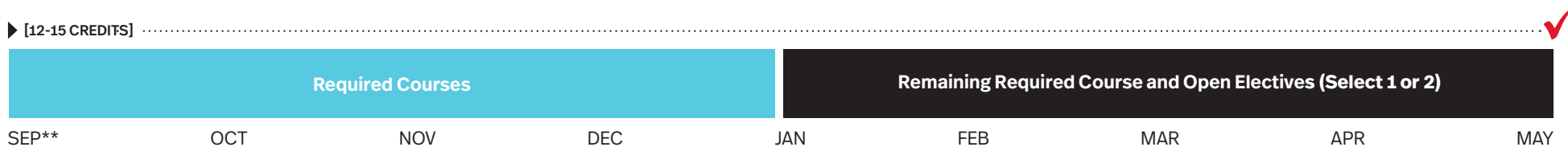
Develop your essential finance knowledge and accelerate your path to an MBA.
