TWO STUDY OPTIONS

Our graduate certificate programs can be completed at a flexible pace on our Boston campus, or 100% online (if offered). The average time to complete both formats is two semesters.

Part-time, flexible pace up to 3 years

- Designed for working professionals in the Boston area
- Classes offered Monday–Thursday at 5:20 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.
- Curriculum of four–six courses
- Students may enroll on our Boston campus in January or September

Online, flexible pace up to 2 years (available for some programs)

- Designed for working professionals around the world
- Self-designed learning schedule; courses can be taken anytime
- Curriculum of four courses (12 credits)
- Students may enroll online in January, February, April, June, October or November
