The D'Amore McKim PlusOne MS in Finance will hone your analytic and financial management skills to prepare you to lead in a tech-driven financial world. Count credits toward your master's as an undergraduate, and finish your degree in just one semester after graduation. If you want to pursue the Chartered Financial Analyst designation, your coursework will help you prepare for the exams.

The first step is to talk with your undergraduate advisor. Ideally, during your sophomore year to enroll in the appropriate classes during the summer of your junior year. Options may be limited after this time frame.

Undergraduate students planning to pursue this program must save two finance electives and two open electives to be eligible to begin in the fall.
