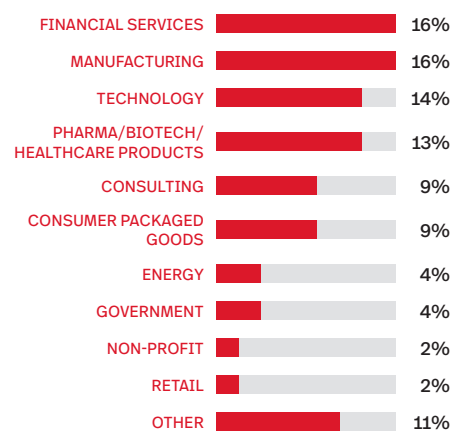
Employment Statistics

EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY

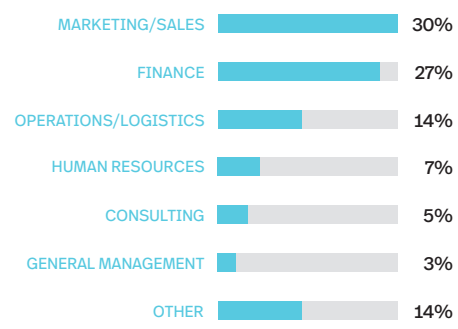

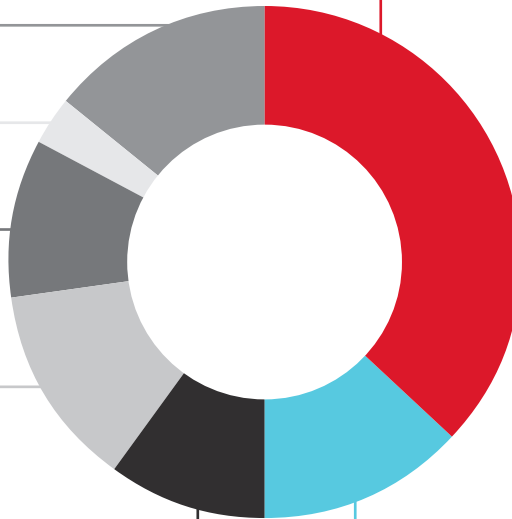
