Basics of Graduate Financial Aid

- File the FAFSA
 - Studentaid.gov
 - FSA ID
 - Northeastern University school code is 002199
- The FAFSA is academic year specific
 - Summer and Fall 2024 part of 2024-25 academic year in FAFSA
- Graduate students are independent by default
 - No parental information needed on FAFSA





Types of Aid Available

Institutional Scholarships

- Departmental Scholarships
 - Awarded by the Graduate School of Professional Accounting directly
 - Merit-based

Double Husky Scholarship

- Available to alumni who have graduated with a Northeastern University degree
- 25% Tuition Scholarship

Types of Aid Available (cont.)

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan

- Up to \$20,500 per academic year
- Interest rates fixed yearly. For current rates visit: <u>https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/types/loans/interest-rates</u>
- Interest accrues while in school
- No credit check required

Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan

- Can borrow up to Cost of Attendance less other aid
- Interest rates fixed yearly. For current rates visit: <u>https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/types/loans/interest-rates</u>
- Interest accrues while in school
- Credit check required



Other Financing Options

Federal Work Study

- Funding is not deducted from bill
- Student works and earns paycheck
- Work Study eligibility is need-based

Private Student Loans

- Apply directly with lender
- Credit check required; interest rate based on credit history

Monthly Payment Plan

- No interest payment plans, low sign-up fee
- Divides costs over a semester



Other Financing Options (cont.)



VA Benefits

- Wide variety of options, including Post-9/11 GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon
- Certification process required

Tips for Navigating the Process

- Ask questions and don't make assumptions
- Use contact information that will likely be stable
 - Try not to use school emails that will shut down once you leave institution, or email addresses not regularly used
 - Most official emails will go to your Northeastern email address once you have one, so be sure to check it regularly
- Do your research
- Don't be afraid to ask for help


